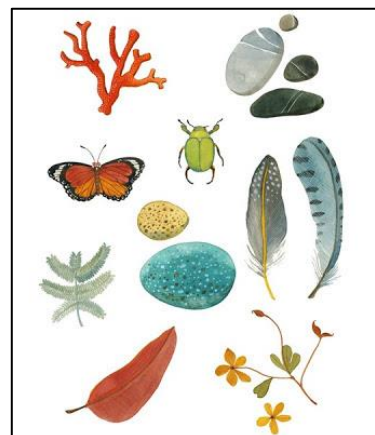
These days we collect little treasures while on holidays, such as seashells, seaweed, rocks, feathers, insects and other things, to remind us of a memorable time.
